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Winning Bidders-

If you are the winning Environmental Firm- the following information will be need to be sent to the assigned Coordinator of your agreement in within 48 hours.

- Current Business License
- Current State of Tennessee Contractor License
- Certificate of Insurance (COI) to include:
 - General Liability Insurance policy must list the City of Memphis as the certificate holder, located at 170 North Main Street, Memphis, Tennessee 38103 with a minimum of \$1,000,000 coverage.
 - Comprehensive General Liability Insurance, including Premises and Operations, Contractual Liability, Independent Contractor's Liability, and Broad Form Property and Damage Liability Coverage.
 - Current Automobile Liability with minimum limit of \$1,000,000 per occurrence on all owned, hired, and non-owned autos.
- Current National EPA RRP Firm/ Worker Certification
- Current State of Tennessee- TDEC Firm Certification
- Current State of Tennessee- TDEC Supervisor/ Worker Certification
- City of Memphis- Section 3 Opportunity Plan (Final Report must be submitted after completion of work)
- DUNS Registration (Must have an assigned DUNS Number to register on SAM.gov website) SAM.gov registration (Must receive "active" status and be assigned a CAGE Code when verified)
- Covid 19 forms- (Release of Liability, PPE Liability Agreement for all potential workers of assigned job) Risk Assessment needed for daily interview while job is in progress.
